## 3 SEEK [v1]

- [v1] the *If* is not a question. It means *for as much* as It is directed as a statement of Faith in the finished work of Christ *Rom. 4:25 Does your faith* rest in what Jesus has done for you? Is He your personal Savior?
- Risen –[sunegeiro soon egg l' ro] unity in arousal. In [2:12], Paul take the words for bury and risen and adds another word sun –[soon] which means a union with; forming two new words that mean we shared in His death and His resurrection. Once more we are reminded that there is no life apart from Christ Eph. 2:1

Are you in Christ? 2 Cor. 13:5

This passage challenges us to know - and we can know for sure through the witness of the Holy Spirit. *Rom.8:1,14-16* 

Paul tells you to seek.-To set your will upon. This is not a casual matter. No weekend spiritual warrior, but an all out pursuit of those things above Matt.6:19-21; 2 Cor.4:16-18

All that is around us will burn and decay. Jesus is the only one that continues and all that He blesses will last.

Where Christ sits – This is a subtle reminder that what we seek is a finished work.

On the Cross, Jesus paid a full price for a complete redemption for all who would believe *Heb.10:12-14*At the right hand – Though it may go without saying, I'm saying it anyway – this is the position of favor, privilege, and power. It is the place you are destined to hold *Rev.3:21* 

## 12SET [v2-3]

[v2] Set your affection – A doubling of the Greek word. Paul is not stuttering, he does this for emphasis. Let the "set of your mind" be on the eternal, not on the temporary; for this world is in the death grip of the old system. Rom12:1-2

How do you do this? How do you "set your affection"? Rom6:2-4

[Know, reckon, yield, obey] Paul reminds of our Standing in Christ. Dead to the penalty, power, presence of sin.

Why should we **set ourselves** in this way? Why is this so important that Paul would be compelled to emphasize the resurrection of Christ – the greatest display of power in the Universe?

[v3] BECAUSE you are *Dead* – it means to die off, be separate from. If you are in Christ then you are dead to the old, for there is no old – it is cut off. There is only one way and that is in Christ. The fact is, that there was never any other way but Christ! John14:6

Your life is hid with Christ - It is not seen from the surface but it is known by faith. "I cannot see the anchor but I feel its pull." 2 Cor.5:14-15,17

In God - We have a Father that promises to us that we have His gift through His Son Jesus Titus 1:2 The God who gave His Son for you has also purposed you for the skies. He wants to and will do what He promised. Eph. 2:10

Setting your will upon Christ is not a "set it and forget it" event. It is a process that relies on the Holy Spirit to do what only He can do Phil2:12-13 He is more than able to do what we can never do but He requires your willing heart.

## 15 SOON [v4]

- When Christ Now there's a good question! All we have is the promise of Jesus. Rev. 22:20
- 7.0 Who is our life Make no mistake, Jesus is not just an addition to your human endeavor to excel, He is very life 1 John 5:11-12
- √ Shall appear –Don't ever forget Jesus made a promise John14:3

And when He does appear you will be different.

- Mhat was promised on the inside by the presence of the Holy Spirit within Eph. 1:13-14 Will be reveal on the outside 1 John 3:2 Appear with Him in glory – The final removal of sin
- √I from our being and the eternal company of the Son of God. 2 Cor. 5:6-9
